### Answers

1. God's Plan is

to make each one of us part of His Family (2 Cor 6:18; Eph 1:5 & 3:14-15).

2. God tells us about His Holy Days in

Leviticus 23 (Lev 23:1-44).

3. We still keep these Feasts today,

just like Christ and the early Christians did (John 7:10; Acts 20:16; 1 Cor 5:7-8).

4. God made the Sabbath holy by

resting on it (Gen 2:1-3).

5. The Passover reminded the Israelites of

the fact that the Death Angel passed over their houses (Ex 12:23 & 12:26-27).

6. Jesus died so

we can be saved from death (John 3:16; Rom 5:9-10).

7. The Days of Unleavened Bread picture the fact that

sin must not be part of our lives (1 Cor 5:7-8; Rom 6:10-12).

8. If we want to live forever then

it's very important to obey God (Matt 19:16-17).

9. God gives us His Holy Spirit to

help us live His Way of Life (John 14:15-16,26).

10. God isn't calling the whole world to

understand His truth now (John 6:44,65; Mark 4:11-12).

11. Jesus Christ is returning to

this earth to set up the Kingdom of God (Matt 24:30-31; Rev 11:15).

12. Satan has to be removed

so he can't deceive people any more (Rev 20:1-3).

13. The Feast of Tabernacles pictures a

wonderful time of peace and happiness (Isa 9:6-7 & 11:4-10; Rev 20:6).

14. The Last Great Day pictures a time when

those God didn't call will be resurrected back to physical life (Rev 20:11-13; John 5:29).

15. Everyone who decides to live God's way will be

changed from a human to a spirit being (1 Cor 15:50-53).

16. The Holy Days picture each step that has to take place before

we can all become part of God's Family (There isn't a specific Scripture to prove this. It is something we learn when we understand what the Holy Days mean. But Eph 1:5-11 & 3:8-11; 1 Cor 2:7-10 talk about God's Plan and Christ's part in it).

17. God wants us to celebrate His Holy Days and

remember His Plan (Lev 23:1-2, 37-38).
