Answers

Leviticus 23:5

The Lord's Passover
is on the fourteenth
day of the first month.
It begins at twilight.

Leviticus 23:6

The Feast of Unleavened
Bread begins on the
fifteenth day of the
same month. You will
eat bread made without
yeast for seven days.

Leviticus 23:7

On the first day of
this feast you will
have a holy meeting. On
that day you must not
do any work.

Leviticus 23:8(b)

There will be a holy
meeting on the seventh
day. And on that day
you must not do any
ordinary work.
