

Challenge Questions

Passover and the Days of Unleavened Bread

Instructions: Read the referenced scriptures before answering each question; they will give you more information and a deeper understanding of the events covered in this Lesson. (Please note that Questions 4 and 9 require more than a yes or no answer!)

1. When Jesus was young, did He go to Jerusalem with His parents, who kept the Passover every year? (Luke 2:40-42)
2. Will Christ keep the Passover in the future, after He establishes the kingdom of God on this earth? (Luke 22:15-16)
3. Does the Bible clearly show that it was necessary for Christ to die by the shedding of His blood for the forgiveness of our sins? (Hebrews 9:22; Ephesians 1:7)
4. What does Christ's death make possible for us; how are we saved? (Romans 5:10)
5. Should we continue to sin? (Romans 6:1-2, 15)
6. Can leaven be a symbol of sin (the wrong practices of the Pharisees and Sadducees for example)? (Matthew 16:6, 11-12)
7. Is Egypt a symbol for sin? (Hebrews 11:24-27)
8. Were the Israelites to especially remember their deliverance from Egypt? (Exodus 13:3)
9. How did God provide an escape route for the trapped Israelites? (Exodus 14:13-16, 19-22)
10. Does God command His people to eat unleavened bread during this festival? (Exodus 13:7)
