

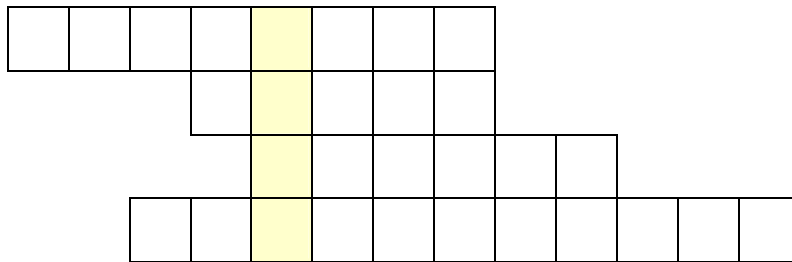
The Twelve Apostles

The Day of Pentecost

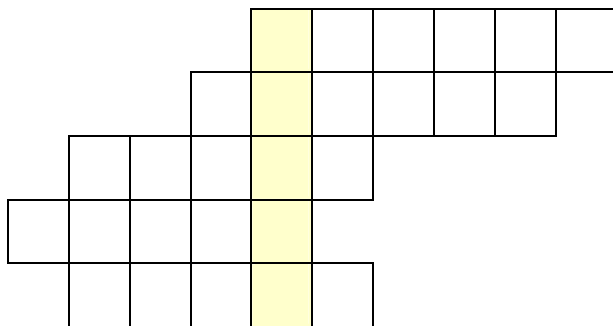

about the great things God has done!"

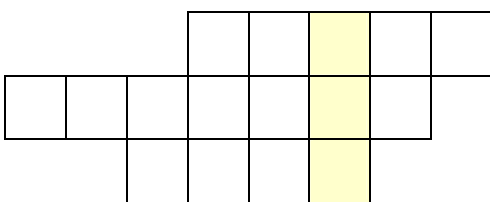
