

## TIME-LINE

Age 12 and Baptism — Luke 2:41—3:38 and Matthew 3:13—17

The purpose of this activity is to create a **TIME-LINE** of Christ's life. Writing down when things happened biblically and historically will reinforce your learning and help to solidify this information in your mind. This **TIME-LINE** can be used for each of the following Teen Lessons about the Life of Christ.

### Instructions

Using the attached time-line, plot the Life of Christ using information from the Lesson. Write down scriptures to back up your information and note down any historical facts alongside it.

For example: We know that King Herod existed historically, so write down **Matthew 2:16** above the time-line in the area of Historical Evidence. Underneath the scripture note that Jesus Christ was born and that King Herod ordered that all boys under the age of 2 years should be killed. Further along the line, in the section below for Biblical Evidence, make a note of **Luke 2:42-50**, when Jesus was found by his parents in the synagogue talking and asking questions - going about His Father's business. Remember to show clear gaps between your entries to indicate the length of time that passed between each one (i.e. 12 years between Christ's birth and the episode in the synagogue, and then a further 18 years until He was baptised, etc...).
